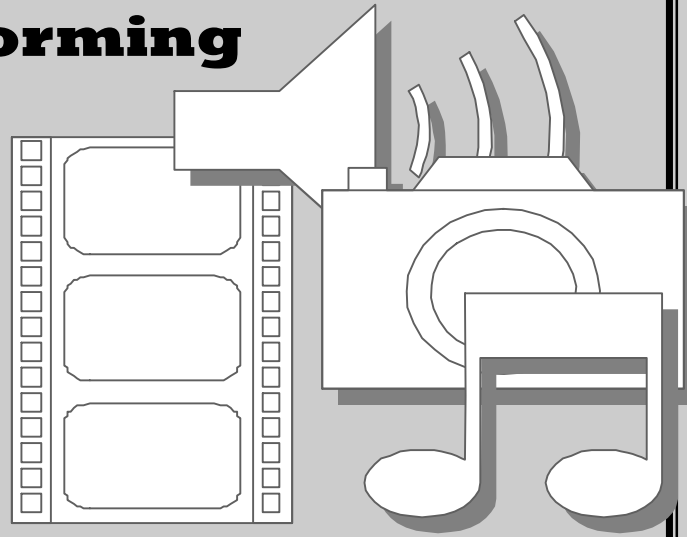


Fine, Visual, Performing Arts

FINE/VISUAL ART

Advanced Art II & III

Credit: 1.00

Duration: One Year

Available for Grades: 10, 11, and 12

Prerequisite: One year of Visual Arts with B or better or Teacher Approval

Meets Graduation Requirements For: Fine, Visual, or Performing Arts or Elective

Description: Students work on advanced techniques and skills with an emphasis on showing and displaying their work. Students will work in a variety of areas (ceramics, sculpture, drawing, and painting in a variety of media). This class is for students who have had one year of art and want to continue working in advanced skills.



Introduction to Fine Arts

Credit: 1.00

Duration: One Year

Available for grades: 9, 10, 11 and 12

Meets Graduation Requirements For: Fine, Visual, or Performing Arts or Elective

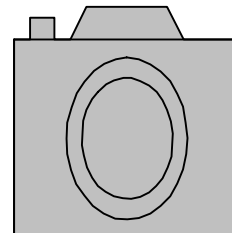
Description: Design will introduce basic techniques in pencil, pastels, India ink, charcoal, tempera paint, sculpture, watercolor acrylics, collage and calligraphy. Projects will emphasize the principles and elements of: perspective, composition and design, which will include: color, line, texture, shape, value, form, pattern and space.

Digital Photography

Credit: 1.00

Duration: One Year

Available for Grades: 9, 10, 11, and 12



Meets Graduation Requirements For: Fine, Visual, or Performing Arts, Occupational Education, or Elective

Cost: \$16.00 for Skills USA membership. \$20.00 for miscellaneous photo paper and photo framing products.

Description: Digital Photography will combine photo taking with current computer technology. This hands on class will show students how a camera operates, how to take good pictures, how to utilize light, and how to use photo shop. It will also include the history of photography, light theory, and special effects.



Yearbook

Credit: 1.00

Duration: One Year

Available for Grades: 9, 10, 11 and 12

Teacher Approval: Must Apply with Teacher

Prerequisite: Computer, typing, art and/or photography; teacher approval

Meets Graduation Requirements for: Fine, Visual and Performing Arts (with instructor permission) or Elective

Description: Yearbook is designed to teach students the fundamentals of layout design, computer production, clear copy writing, and the essentials of putting every element together to create a finished product. Students will be expected to work weekends and after school to meet deadline requirements. All students are required to spend a minimum of eight hours outside of class working on yearbook related activities, attend conferences, and come in before or after school for management meetings. Students should approach the course with enthusiasm and dedication. It is necessary for students to apply for admittance to this class.

Advanced Choir I, II

Credit: 1.00

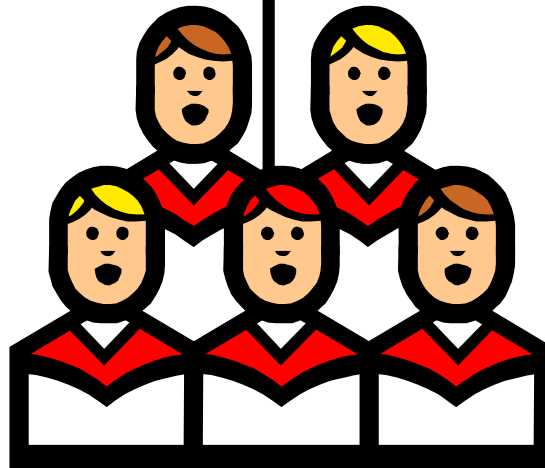
Duration: One Year

Available for Grades: 9, 10, 11 and 12

Prerequisite: One year of choir and/or teacher permission.

Description: Students will be taught advanced techniques of vocal production and musical style. There will be at least one performance each semester in which the student is required to participate. The second semester class will perform in the SWW Massed Choir Festival. There is a dress code for all performances: Boys—nice dress shirt and pants (no blue jeans) and shoes without holes. Available for Grades: 9, 10, 11 and 12

Prerequisite: Teacher approval—audition with director

There will be at least one performance each semester in which the student is required to participate. Concert Band I, II

Credit: 1.00

Duration: One Year

Available for Grades: 9,

10, 11 and 12

Prerequisite: Must have an instrumental foundation to be compatible with high school band.

Meets Graduation Requirements For:
Fine, Visual or Performing Arts

Description: concert Band students will perform a wide variety of music literature from marching to concert and will represent the school at all concerts, musical activities and sporting events. The marching band will travel to parades in the spring. A varsity letter will be awarded to students who participate in 90% of the performances. Students are expected to refine and improve upon the fundamental aspects of instrumental music: tone, intonation, articulation, dynamics, scales, chords, key signature, time signature, musical terms, proficient use of instrument, performance skills and sight reading.

Duration: One Year

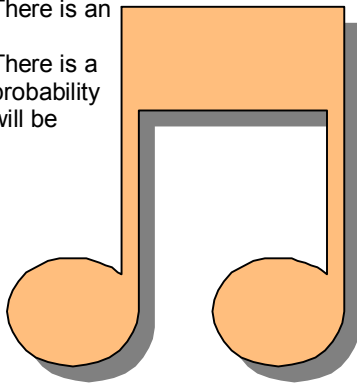
Available for Grades: 9, 10, 11 and 12

Duration: One Year

Available for Grades: 9, 10, 11 and 12

Prerequisite: Teacher approval—audition with director

Meets Graduation Requirements For: Fine, Visual or Performing Arts or Elective



Description: To allow students with proper interest and talent to learn the techniques of jazz articulation, phrasing, music theory and styles of jazz literature. The band will also be used as a vehicle to develop

individual jazz soloists, through performance of the above criteria. The jazz ensemble members are required to perform with the pep, concert, and marching bands. The jazz ensemble will travel to contests and festivals each spring.

Speech I, II

Credit: 1.00

Duration: One Year

Available for Grades: 9, 10, 11 and 12

Prerequisite: None

Meets Graduation Requirements For: Fine, Visual, or Performing Arts or Elective

Description: This course is aimed at preparing students for competition in forensics. Students will be expected to compose and deliver three individual event speeches or prepare and compete in debate competitions. All students will be required to attend at least one speech tournament.



Swing Choir I, II

Credit: 1.00

Duration: One Year

Available for Grades: 9, 10, 11 and 12

Prerequisite: Audition required

Meets Graduation Requirements For: Fine, Visual or Performing Arts or Elective

Cost: Uniform and tour costs



Description: Students will be taught advanced techniques of vocal production and musical style. There is an emphasis on showmanship and performance. There are many performances required throughout the year; also, participation in fundraisers. There is a contest and/or tour planned each spring. Outfits are required for each member.
